YOUR STAY

Your room will be serviced every morning up until 11.00am. In an attempt to reduce environmental impact we will only replace towels left in your shower tray. If you do not wish to be disturbed please leave the sign provided on the outside of your door.

Wi-Fi is available free of charge. Please select the following network - SKYCE43F. The password is EVPQRTVW

Check out is by 10am on the day of departure. Please note that our check in times are from 11am therefore we can not allow any later check out than 10am.

Please do not eat takeaways in your room.

There are ironing facilities outside room 1 on the ground floor.

Accidents happen, if you spill or damage anything please tell us. (On rare occasions we may have to charge for breakages or damage).

It is great to have a good night's sleep. We do not have a curfew as many guest houses do, so we would appreciate you being quiet when returning to the guest house especially after 11pm, as other guests may be asleep.

The nearest public telephone box is at the bottom of Thornbarrow Road on the right over the zebra crossing. In an emergency, a telephone will be made available.

WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE

THE ASSEMBLY POINT IS AT THE FRONT OF THE BUILDING ON THORNBARROW ROAD

INVERGARRY IS FITTED WITH HEAT AND SMOKE DETECTORS, FIRE DOORS AND A FIRE ALARM SYSTEM.

IF THE ALARM SOUNDS:

- Evacuate the building by the nearest exit, the front door, and report at the assembly point
- Do not wait to collect personal belongings
- Close doors on your way out
- Do not re-enter the building until it has been declared safe to do so
- Wait at the assembly point until a roll call has been taken

IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE:

- Break the glass at the nearest fire point
- Use appropriate extinguisher to tackle the blaze if you are able to do so without endangering life
- Alert the proprietors by ringing the bell in the entrance hall or call 07502 429633
- If you are able to, call the fire brigade by dialing 999
